By signing this agreement, I will abide by the following rules:

1. If there are more than 5 competitors of a single gender on a mixed gender team, there must be 2 coaches, one of each gender. (If there are multiple teams as part of a group, the rule applies to the group and not individual teams)
2. Coaches must be with their teams for the duration of the tournament
3. Coaches must ensure their team follows all rules/guidelines listed on the MIST Nashville website and explained in trainings/orientation
4. It is my responsibility to ensure all competitors on my team meet the requirements to compete and attend the schools they register with.
5. Coaches must ensure all students, coaches and guests have registered through the official MIST registration process within the given timeline. It will be the responsibility of the coach to turn away any guests or competitors that are attempting to join their group if they are unregistered
6. Coaches are responsible for ensuring all students are attending with the correct id badges and are not using any other participants badges
7. Coaches must be with any competitors from their team that wish to stay at a hotel
8. Coaches are responsible for the etiquette/manners of their team in order to ensure there is no bullying, harassment ect occurring
9. Coaches are responsible for ensuring there is no improper gender interaction between their team as established in the code of conduct
10. Coaches are responsible for ensuring their team meets the dress code
11. A coach must be present for any official team meetings
12. I will report any altercations or incidents with another team, organizer, volunteer or judge directly to the head coach of my team (head coaches are responsible for reporting these to the Regional Director or an Associate Director)

Failure to comply with any of the statements indicated above may result in:

1. Removal of the coach from the regional tournament for the current year and/or bans from future tournaments
2. A loss of placement for the team as a whole (best team/group award ect)
